

Privacy policy for Internetdagarna

Processing of personal data

The Swedish Internet Foundation arranges the conference “Internetdagarna” and is responsible for the processing of your personal data in relation to the conference.

Personal data, such as name, address, telephone number, personal ID number (for personal invoices), which you provide when you register for the conference, are collected by The Swedish Internet Foundation in order to arrange the conference. The personal data are saved for as long as required by The Swedish Internet Foundation to complete the administration for the conference, normally until January of the following year. Email addresses are saved for 18 months in order for you to receive information about next year’s Internetdagarna. Accounting records are saved in accordance with the Accounting Act.

Personal data (such as name and title) concerning event organisers, speakers or exhibitors at the conference are processed by The Swedish Internet Foundation in order to organise the conference, spread knowledge about internet and to inform about Internetdagarna. Information about organizers may be published on are processed by The Swedish Internet Foundations’ website, in programmes or articles. Programmes and articles from previous Internetdagarna are stored in archives on the Internetdagarna website. Accounting records are saved in accordance with the Accounting Act.

Photography and live broadcasting

There will be photographs taken, recordings and live broadcasting of the various events during Internetdagarna. The Swedish Internet Foundation is responsible for images and films where you occur. Pictures, sound and broadcastings may be published on are processed by The Swedish Internet Foundations websites or social media accounts. You are, at any time, able to contact The Swedish Internet Foundation in writing requesting your personal data not to be used in The Swedish Internet Foundations communication.

Purposes and legal basis for processing

The purposes of the processing of the personal data is for The Swedish Internet Foundation to be able to arrange the Internetdagarna and fulfil its obligations under the terms and conditions applicable to participants at the conference, to event organisers and to speakers or exhibitors at the conference.

For example, the data may be processed in order to:

- identify you when you check in at the Internetdagarna,
- process conference registrations and handle other practical planning concerning your participation at the Internetdagarna,
- communicate information about events,
- process invoices and payments,
- process enquiries from participants, speakers, event organisers or exhibitors and to administer the conference in general,
- provide information about and develop the Internetdagarna and to send newsletters which may contain information and offers about services provided by The Swedish Internet Foundation,
- manage customer surveys etc.

The Swedish version of this policy shall prevail.

In order for The Swedish Internet Foundation to process your personal data, there must be a legal basis for the processing. The legal basis for the processing is the fulfilment of the agreement with you as a participant, speaker, exhibitor or event organiser at the Internetdagarna.

Images, recordings and broadcasts from Internetdagarna may be published on The Swedish Internet Foundations' website or in social media. The legal basis for the publication is legitimate interest, to enable a wider audience to participate in the event, to spread knowledge about the Internet and to inform about the Internetdagarna.

The legal basis for processing of personal data concerning participants representing registered companies (legal entities), processing of personal data in relation to newsletters is legitimate interest.

Recipient of personal data

Your personal data may be processed by partners or suppliers contracted by The Swedish Internet Foundation to fulfil commitments to you.

For example, The Swedish Internet Foundation cooperates with the following partners or suppliers:

- Event managers for arranging the Internetdagarna
- Exhibitors and event organisers at the Internetdagarna
- Event organisers at the Internetdagarna
- Speakers at the Internetdagarna
- Survey company for customer surveys.
- Service providers for handling registrations, payments and customer support.
- Service provider for the mailing of newsletters.

The Swedish Internet Foundation may use a service for online meetings if Internetdagarna is arranged online. If so, the personal data that you share when registering for the event, when the event starts or during the event, may be shared with the partner that provides the service on The Swedish Internet Foundation's behalf.

Partners or suppliers may have part of their operations outside Sweden or EU/EEA. If The Swedish Internet Foundation transfers data to such partners or suppliers, The Swedish Internet Foundation ensures, inter alia, by agreement that personal data is processed and protected in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.

Disclosure

The Swedish Internet Foundation may disclose personal data to its partners and suppliers as part of arranging the event.

Personal data such as images, recordings and live broadcasts from the Internetdagarna may be published on social media and on the Internetdagarna website.

Personal data may also be disclosed when prescribed by law or regulation, due to an ongoing legal process or following a mandatory request by a government authority.

The Swedish version of this policy shall prevail.

Your rights

You have the right to request registry extracts free of charge containing the personal data that The Swedish Internet Foundation is processing about you.

You have the right to request incorrect data to be corrected. Subject to limitations provided in the data protection legislation, you also have the right to request that your data is deleted, or its use restricted.

Subject to limitations provided in the data protection legislation, you also have the right to object to any processing of personal data. If personal data is processed solely based on your consent, you always have the right to withdraw such consent.

Subject to limitations provided in the data protection legislation, you also have the right to receive personal data provided by you in a structured, generally used and machine-readable format.

In order to request correction, deletion, restriction of processing, access to personal data or to use the right to extract personal data provided by you, please contact the Data Protection Officer at The Swedish Internet Foundation, dataskyddsbud@internetstiftelsen.se.

If you no longer wish to receive the Internetdagarna' newsletter, you can choose to stop the service by using the link at the end of your email or newsletter.
